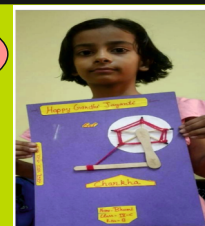

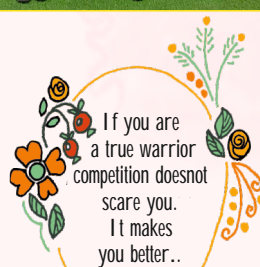


★ ★ ★ INTER-BRANCH ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ English Fest 2022-23 ★ ★ ★
